

Destination Kiama 2018/19 Partnership Terms and Conditions

1. Destination Kiama Partnership is on a financial year basis (01 July 2018 to 30 June 2019).
2. The level of partnership selected should be dependent upon the level of services the business/event wishes to receive (as per the Partnership Prospectus 2018/19).
3. Receipt of an application does not guarantee acceptance of a partnership with Destination Kiama. Acceptance or otherwise of an Application for Partnership will depend on the information supplied and relevant compliance with statutory requirements. Refused applications will have the full partnership fee returned.
4. For partnership to be approved, payment in full must be accompanied by a signed Partnership Application form. Current partners who remain unpaid at 30 October 2018 will be marked as inactive on the Destination Kiama website and brochures will be removed from the Kiama Visitors Centre and will remain as such until all fees are paid.
5. Accommodation Operators **MUST** include a Certificate of Currency of their Public Liability Insurance with their Partnership Application form.
6. The Visitors Centre will only display one DL size brochure per partnership. Larger sized or additional brochures subject to agreement with Destination Kiama. It is the responsibility of the partner to ensure the Kiama Visitors Centre has an adequate supply of brochures and that stock is replenished when requested by the Kiama Visitors Centre.
7. Any photos supplied to Destination Kiama are copyright cleared and can be used to promote your business in all forms of media without further consent.
8. Destination Kiama retains the right to cease promotion of any operator who;
 - Acts in a manner considered to be unprofessional, or that would potentially bring the operations of Destination Kiama into question or disrepute.
 - Acts in such a way that harms the reputation of the destination as a whole
 - Acts in a manner we consider poses public safety or liability concerns
