JOIN THE WEATHER; GET WET!

If a little bit of water doesn't frighten you, then here are some activities that epitomise the old saying "if you can't beat 'em, join 'em"!

In the warmer seasons enjoy the water activities of Jamberoo Action Park (September to Easter) or check out Minnamurra Falls under the rainforest canopy at Minnamurra Rainforest.

We are famous for our blowholes which are happy rain or shine - it all depends on the wind direction. The Kiama Blowhole loves a SE swell while the Little Blowhole prefers the more common NE swell.

Perhaps you'll enjoy a rainy dip in one of our 5 ocean pools: two in Kiama and three in Gerrigong?!

Maybe even take a surf or SUP lesson, hire a kayak or a stand-up paddleboard.

Or head north to Shellharbour or south to Huskisson for dolphin or whale watching tours.
