## Dharawal Country

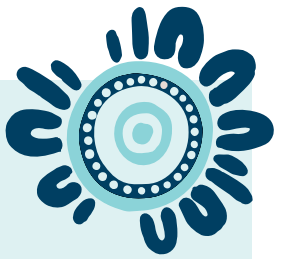

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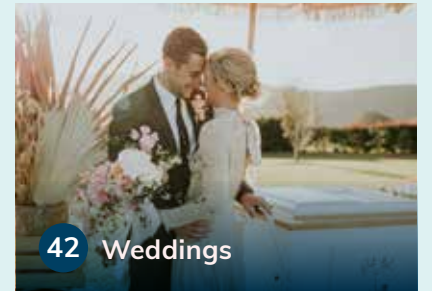
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## Mayor's welcome



# Towns & villages

Beyond the landscapes, it's the townships that give the Kiama region its soul. Each one carries its own personality. Some lively and creative, others quiet and reflective. Discover surf culture and boutique flair, hinterland communities steeped in heritage and hospitality, and places where food, wellness, and nature blend effortlessly. Together, they shape the rhythm of the region.



## Gerringong

Perched above Warri Beach, Gerringong is a postcard-perfect coastal village. With hills tumbling to the sea, it offers surf and boutique shopping, buzzing cafés, a standout winery, and a small-batch brewery. Families and beach lovers can enjoy sun, surf, and parks, while hikers can explore the southern gateway to the Kiama Coast Walk. Gerringong perfectly balances relaxed charm with trendy beach culture, making it ideal for exploring, sampling local delights, or simply unwinding in a vibrant seaside setting.



## Kiama

Winner of NSW's Top Tourism Town and ranked third nationally, Kiama blends adventure, culture, and relaxation. Explore the scenic Kiama Coast Walk, watch the iconic Blowholes in action, or unwind at boutique cafés and stylish stays. From lively festivals and markets to peaceful winter retreats, Kiama offers unforgettable experiences in every season.



## Gerroa

Nestled beside Seven Mile Beach National Park, Gerroa is a peaceful coastal sanctuary. Its pristine beaches and gentle waves attract swimmers, surfers, and windsurfers, while the cafe and restaurant offers a great spot to soak up the scenery. Whether you're catching your first wave, strolling along the shoreline, or enjoying the calm coastal atmosphere, Gerroa blends soft adventure with serenity. It's the perfect place to connect with nature, unwind, and enjoy a tranquil seaside escape.



## Bombo & Minnamurra

Bombo's rugged rock formations and dramatic coastline offer breathtaking views, while Minnamurra invites kayaking, paddleboarding, and golf. Adventure continues along the north section of Kiama Coast Walk, and a short drive inland leads to the Minnamurra Rainforest with elevated walkways, waterfalls, and lush greenery. Together, these areas create three unique landscapes for exploration and relaxation. Visitors can discover dramatic coastal scenery, serene rivers, and tropical rainforest all in one unforgettable day trip.



## Jamberoo

Just a short drive inland, Jamberoo invites visitors into rolling hills, lush rainforest trails, and welcoming country hospitality. Adventure-lovers can take on the slides at Jamberoo Action Park or soar along the zipline at Illawarra Fly. Prefer a gentler pace? Enjoy scenic drives, peaceful swimming holes, and hearty meals at the welcoming local pub. Jamberoo is where rustic charm meets outdoor adventure, offering the perfect mix of family-friendly fun, nature experiences, and a relaxed rural escape close to the coast.



# History & heritage

To truly understand Kiama's story, start with the echoes of the past. From the enduring connection of the Dharawal people to the milestones that have shaped our region, our history is rich and layered.

## *An abundant land*

For thousands of years, Kiama was both a destination and a crossroads for the nomadic Wodi Wodi people of the Dharawal Nation. They travelled regularly with the seasons, drawing on the region's abundant flora and fauna, freshwater fish and seafood. Evidence of this long connection can still be seen today, including traditional middens at the Minnamurra River mouth.

Many elements of nature are represented through totems in Aboriginal culture. Along the Kiama Coast Walk, the Dreaming Poles sculptures reflect this deep relationship between people, land and sea. The cabbage tree palms found throughout the region are one such totem and were also an important resource for the Wodi Wodi people. Their leaves were used to make shelter and mats, strips of fibre were crafted into fishing line, and the heart of the tree was reserved for special ceremonial purposes.



## *New industries, new growth*

European settlement in the Kiama region began at the turn of the 19th century, quickly transforming the landscape. Ancient cedar forests were felled and shipped to help build a growing nation, while the rich basalt and quartz deposits fueled mining and construction booms. Many of the region's iconic structures date from this period, including Kiama Harbour (1876), the Post Office (1878), and the Lighthouse (1887).

The 20th century brought the railway, refrigeration, and a surge in tourism, alongside a thriving dairy industry that took root in the lush green fields. Today, you can step back in time and explore Kiama's European heritage at the Pilot's Cottage Museum on Blowhole Point or the Gerringong Library and Museum.



## *Gurrungutch, the Great Giant Eel*

Stories passed down through generations connect this Country to deep cultural meaning - like the tale of Gurrungutch, the Great Giant Eel, which speaks to the creation of Cathedral Rocks and the Kiama Blowholes. These stories, and the enduring connection to land and sea, continue to shape the spirit of this place.

### The Blowholes

Witness the power of the ocean in action at Kiama's famous Blowhole and Little Blowhole – nature's own spectacular water show and the region's most iconic sight.



### Kiama Coast Walk

Follow approximately 20km of sealed paths, grassy trails, beach sections, and gentle hills along our sparkling coastline – from Minnamurra River to Gerrington, every step offers a new view to savour.



### Minnamurra Rainforest Centre

Immerse yourself in nature beneath towering canopy trees, past waterfalls, and vibrant flora and fauna. The suspended boardwalk and scenic trails offer both stroller-friendly and more challenging options.



### Jamberoo Action Park

Between September and April, make a splash at NSW's favourite water theme park – an all-ages adventure just a short 20min drive inland from Kiama.



### Cathedral Rocks

Marvel at the striking spired formation, best viewed at mid-low tide. A must-visit for photographers and nature lovers chasing the perfect shot.



### Minnamurra River

Forming Kiama's northern border, this tranquil haven invites you to swim, snorkel, paddleboard, fish, or simply enjoy the serenity of its calm waters.



### Bombo Headland

A dramatic geological wonder. Walk among ancient basalt columns and striking coastal rock formations that have featured in countless films and photo shoots.



### Illawarra Fly

Feel the thrill on the escarpment with a treetop walk and eco zipline adventure, offering breathtaking views across the Illawarra and beyond.



### Seven Mile Beach

This endless golden stretch offers something for everyone – surf lessons with Surf Camp Australia, calm river swims, windsurfing, or short National Park walks or mountain biking.



### Ocean Pools

Start your day the local way with a dip in one of our four spectacular saltwater ocean pools across Kiama and Gerrington – the perfect mix of calm and coastal magic.



# Kiama blowholes

Can you hear that? The unmistakable “WOOSH” of these geological marvels, 260 million years in the making — long before the age of the dinosaurs! Shaped by volcanic forces and sculpted by the ocean’s persistence, these two frothy, thunderous wonders are nature’s own showstoppers.

## *Kiama’s iconic Blowhole*

The Kiama Blowhole is the most well-known of the two and is essentially one large vent, which, under pressure, will force a jet of water high into the air (up to 30 metres or eight storeys high in the right conditions!) each time it takes a ‘breath’.

This unique landmark sits on a natural headland, visited by Aboriginal tribes for centuries and given the name ‘Khanterinte’. The first European to make a splash in this area was George Bass in 1797, and some 228 years later, this site is now a hive of activity — home to a bustling harbour, cafes, ocean baths, walking tracks, historic Pilot’s Cottage, lighthouse, and more.

## *The Little Blowhole*

But wait, there’s more! Besides the main Kiama Blowhole, there is also a second Little Blowhole approximately 2km to the south — a short drive to Tingira Crescent or stroll along the Kiama Coast Walk.

The Little Blowhole isn’t as well-known but is undoubtedly worth a visit – especially as it’s often active when its big sibling is not.

Catch them on a good day, and they’ll really blow your mind!



Both of Kiama’s blowholes have accessible viewing platforms suitable for visitors with limited mobility.

## Kiama Coast Walk

6km-20km (1.5-6.5hrs) one way

This is the undisputed jewel in the crown — a coastal spine that stretches 20km from Minnamurra to Gerringong. Along the way, you'll discover many “wow” moments, including dramatic clifftops, secret coves, unspoilt beaches, and delightful detours. It's one of Australia's finest walks; complete the whole thing or one of the three smaller sections.

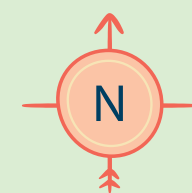

### Minnamurra River to Kiama Blowhole

8.5km | 3 hours | Grade 3 (medium)  
Discover unique rock formations, sheltered coves, golden beaches and panoramic headland views.



### Kiama Blowhole to Loves Bay

5km | 1.5 hours | Grade 3 (medium)  
A delightfully suburban crawl that connects Kiama's blowholes and popular holidaymaking beaches.



### Loves Bay to Gerringong

6km | 1.5 hours | Grade 4 (hard)  
Dramatic views amid bright green headlands, rainforest remnants, rock shelves and train tunnels!





## Other iconic walks

If a local tells you to “take a hike,” don’t take it personally, they’re just pointing you toward some of our world-class walking tracks.

From crashing waves to cascading waterfalls, ancient rainforests to surreal rock formations, there’s a walk to suit every pace and passion.

### Barren Grounds

(2–8km | 30mins–3hrs)

‘Barren’ in name only, this plateau offers sweeping views of countryside and coastline, with seasonal wildflowers and birdlife adding bursts of colour and song.

### Bombo Headland

(2–3km | 1hr)

Step into a moonscape shaped by over a century of blue metal quarrying. Explore surreal basalt columns and dramatic ocean backdrops.

### Carrington Falls

(600m | 30mins)

Short walk, big payoff. This easy trail leads to a stunning lookout, peaceful waterholes, and perfect picnic spots.

### Minnamurra Rainforest

(2–4km | 1–2hrs return | \$12 per car)

Wander through rare rainforest remnants in Budderoo National Park. Choose the accessible Lyrebird Loop or venture further on the Falls Walk.

### The Sand Track, Seven Mile Beach NP

(6–8km | 2–3hrs)

Follow the shoreline or parallel sand track south of Gerroa, through coastal dunes and Blackbutt and Bangalay forest. (Also great for the novice mountain biker.)

## Enjoy the ride

One of the best things about our region is its pocket-sized charm, with hidden gems and local favourites waiting to be uncovered at every turn. Whether by bike or car, take your time to explore the coastline, hinterland, and villages - there’s always more to see, do, and experience.

### Four wheels

There’s something special about hitting the road in the Kiama region - where every turn reveals a new view, and even the shortest drives feel like a scenic escape.

Start with **Tourist Drive 9**, winding west from Kiama through Jamberoo’s dairy country and into rainforest-cloaked hills. Along the way, stop at **Illawarra Fly Treetop Adventure**, **Carrington Falls**, and **Nellies Glen** — all perfect for stretching your legs and soaking in nature.

For a shorter loop, head up **Saddleback Mountain** for panoramic views from the lookout, then cruise back via **Fountaindale Road**, where rolling green hills and grazing cows set the scene.

Or take the **Grand Pacific Drive** north through Shellharbour and over the iconic **Sea Cliff Bridge**, with sweeping ocean views and dramatic cliffside curves. Head south and within an hour you’ll arrive at Jervis Bay. Return to Kiama through Berry or **Shoalhaven Heads**. See page 66 for our public EV charging facilities.”

### Two wheels

Whether you’re cruising the coast or tackling the hills, Kiama offers cycling adventures for every rider.

**Scenic Coastal Rides** – Follow the shared path from Minnamurra River to Kiama, passing Cathedral Rocks, Boneyard, Bombo Headland, and both blowholes. With ocean views and natural lookouts, it’s a ride to remember.

**Family-Friendly Paths** – Enjoy relaxed rides around Kiama’s harbour and beaches or along Gerrington’s Werri Beach. These shared paths are perfect for little legs and easy pedalling.

**Inland Escapes** – The dedicated cycleway from Kiama Downs to Jamberoo winds through farmland and foothills, offering a peaceful inland alternative.

**Off-Road & Skills Tracks** – Seven Mile Beach features forested off-road trails, while Minnamurra Bike Skills Track includes a pump track for all ages.

**Road Cycling Challenges** – Jamberoo Valley and Saddleback Mountain serve up winding lanes and steep climbs — a dream for experienced road cyclists.

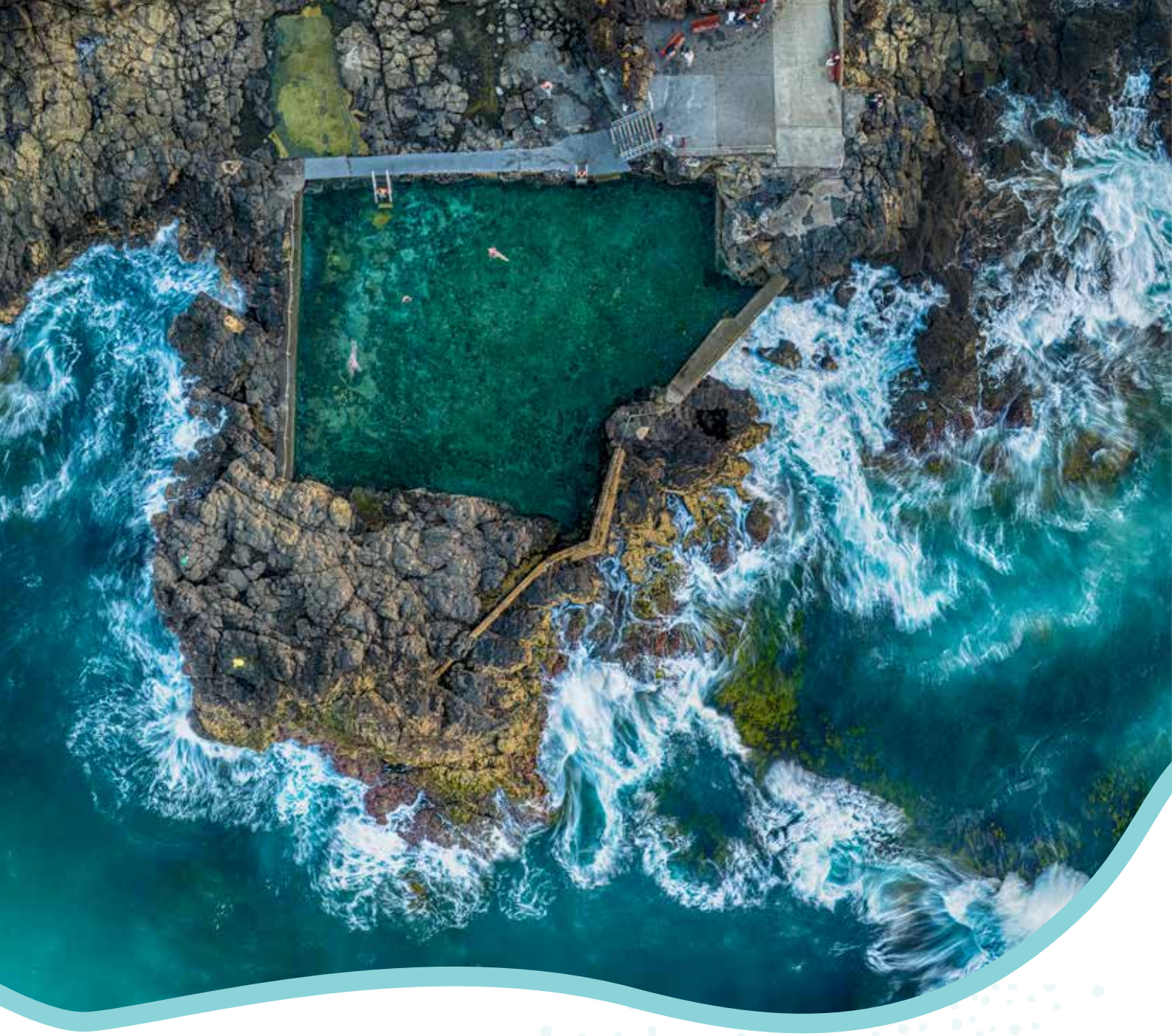

## Make a splash

Master your surfing skills, immerse yourself in an underwater ecosystem, or find your zen while navigating waterways on a stand-up paddleboard or kayak.

### Snorkelling

Don a mask and snorkel and discover a whole world beneath the waves. Popular snorkelling spots include the sheltered beach at Boneyard, Minnamurra River (time your trip with the tides and float downstream), Crooked River, and the northern end of Seven Mile Beach.

### Surfing

Whether you're a pro or a first-time surfer, you'll find the waves to suit your skills along our glorious coastline. Try Jones Beach, Surf Beach, and Werri Beach for world-class waves, or find your feet with a lesson at Seven-Mile Beach, home to plenty of beginner-friendly breaks.

### SUP & kayaking

Meditate with movement as you mindfully navigate the clear waters of the Minnamurra River on a stand-up paddleboard or kayak. Bring your own or arrange a hire for when you get here. It's a serene way to discover our shores.

### Fishing

Cast a line with those who know our waters best. Join Fishing with a Local for guided beach, rock, estuary, and land-based sessions tailored to all skill levels. For an offshore adventure, Kiama Charter Service takes you straight to reefs and deep-sea grounds, with all gear, bait, and tuition included. No licence needed – just come ready for fresh ocean air.

## Fancy a dip?

As well as our iconic surf beaches, our region is spoiled with countless swimming spots offering calmer waters — perfect for a relaxing dip, a few laps, or a splash.

### Ocean pools

Our iconic ocean pools in Kiama and Gerringong are ideal for a dip, whatever the season and whatever the reason.

### Rivers

Crashing waves not your thing? Float in the calm waters of Minnamurra River or Crooked River, Gerroa.

### Swimming holes

You'll find natural swimming holes at Nellies Glen (Budderoo National Park), Campbell's Hole (Gerringong), and Boneyard (Bombo).

### Swimming pools

If you're looking for a man-made swimming pool, try either the Kiama Leisure Centre (heated) or the outdoor pool in Jamberoo.

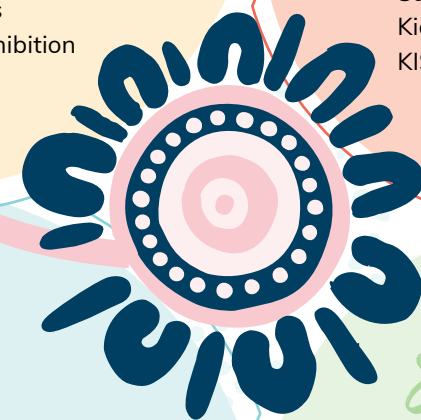

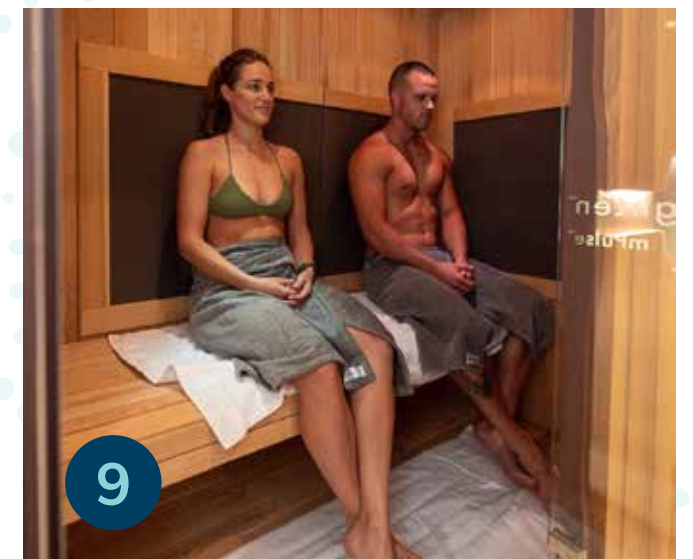

# Action-packed adventures

There's nothing quite like an adventure to set your heart pumping, jaw dropping, spine tingling and eyes popping!



It all begins more than 700 metres above sea level at Illawarra Fly Treetop Adventures — home to Australia's highest zipline. This unforgettable experience caters to all ages, offering breathtaking panoramic views across the region from the ancient rainforest. Want to take it even higher? Jump aboard BIGWAVE Skydive or a helicopter scenic flight from Shellharbour Airport and soak up incredible coastal vistas before touching down at Bass Point Reserve.

Back on solid ground, Jamberoo's rolling green hills set the stage for world-class thrills at Jamberoo Action Park (September–April), NSW's largest family-owned water park. Prefer splashes of a different kind? Seven Mile Beach is perfect for surf lessons with Surf Camp, or BYO windsurf, or foil; while the coastline and Minnamurra River offer ideal conditions for kayaking and stand-up paddleboarding.

Further offshore, you can take a fishing charter from Kiama Harbour, with plenty of opportunities to spot whales, dolphins, and other marine life along the way.

For those seeking other active adventures, the region has plenty to offer: scenic hiking and cycling trails, watersports along the coastline, the adventure playground in Kiama, and the skate park at Kiama Leisure Centre. Whether you crave adrenaline-pumping thrills or gentle exploration, the Kiama region has something for everyone.

#### Afternoon

Treat your dog to an off-leash run at **Bombo Beach**. Watch tails wag as they splash through the shallows and chase a ball along the sand.

#### Evening

Enjoy a relaxed dinner at **KG Café**. Known for its South African-inspired flavours and welcoming outdoor seating, it's a great way to round out your first night in town with your pup by your side.

### Day 2 – Adventure & indulgence

#### Morning

Grab coffee and a pastry from **Slow Dough**, the artisan bakery famous for its sourdough and sweet treats. Dogs are welcome outside, making it an easy morning stop before exploring.

Afterwards, head to the southern end of **Jones Beach** in Kiama Downs for more off-leash fun and views of Cathedral Rocks.

#### Late morning

Explore nearby **Minnamurra Headland**, a huge grassy expanse perfect for pups to roam while you take in panoramic coastal scenery.

#### Lunch

Take the winding road south towards **Gerringong**, where emerald-green hills tumble into the deep blue of the Pacific. It's a drive that feels like the holiday has truly begun. Pull into **Crooked River Estate** and settle in for a long, relaxed lunch – grazing platter on the table, award-winning wine in hand, and your pup happily stretched out beside you as you gaze across the vineyard rows.

Tip: On Friday and Saturday evenings, there's often live music – perfect with a glass at sunset.

### Day 3 – Blowhole grand finale

#### Morning

Start your final morning at Diggies Kiama, where ocean views, barista-style coffee and a fresh breakfast set the tone for the day. Just 150 metres away, the Big Blowhole and Lighthouse offer an easy first stop to enjoy sweeping coastal views. Prefer to stretch the legs a little more? Head south along the headland for around 25 minutes to reach the Little Blowhole, where its signature whoosh never fails to impress. Let your pup stretch their legs and soak up the ocean spray, the perfect way to tire them out before a well-earned backseat snooze.
